ACTIVITY/ATHLETICS PROPOSAL

Phase I: Unity, Pride, & Culture

- Enhance the aesthetics within the secondary buildings
- Through student advisory council, each student group submits a “school pride day” awareness plan
- Through student advisory council, student groups develop a way to welcome back/recognize/involve alumni, professional staff, and families
- Increase school spirit at school events

ACTIVITY/ATHLETICS PROPOSAL

Phase II: Enhancement of existing programs

- Conduct focus groups with existing student activity groups and athletic teams
- Implementation of activity process through next 5 years
- Increase academic performance of students involved in activities and athletics
- Increase the number of students recognized at local, state, and national level
- Increase the number of students involved in community service through their respective activity/sport

ACTIVITY/ATHLETICS PROPOSAL

Phase III: Expansion of programs and facilities

- Creative funding (Field advertising, community examples)
- Facility expansion (locker rooms, another lighted surface, another gymnasium)
- Possibility of new student clubs/supplemental contracts

ACTIVITY/ATHLETICS PROPOSAL

- During all three phases of this process, we plan to:
 - I. Evaluate current activity/athletic philosophy
 - II. Improve methods of communication
 - III. Improve supervision procedures
