DISTRICT WIDE ISSUES

Middle School Renovation: Work continues in administrative, classroom and auxiliary parts of the building. Asbestos abatement is slated to begin on June 19, 2010 which will involve significant use of custodial resources. Sewer and lift station work – on target. Driveway and curb replacement will take place over the summer. *To date, project is about 11% under budget.*

PLE roof replacement: Roofers have submitted Act 34 and 151 clearances to the CCIU for processing. Project is underway – brickwork and flashing will be completed first - and vendor will work with administrative staff to accommodate MAP testing of students. Bob Smith Contracting will be completing mortar replacement/caulking on sidewalks and columns.

PLE Lighting: Currently preparing for bids. Project will also include high school library lights, and some of the middle school lighting may also be applicable for the project. At conclusion of project, District will apply for grant from PECO.

High School Grease Trap replacement: Anticipated to be 3 week project and is slated to begin at conclusion of the school year.

OTHER

Sports Boosters Sign Presentation: Members of the Avon Grove Sports Boosters presented a signage program for the High School stadium and surrounding athletic fields. Program would involve members of Sports Boosters soliciting local businesses to participate – prices for signs would be based on size of sign, location on field, and length of contract. Signs would be made by local vendor, installed and maintained by Sports Boosters. Participants would sign a contract, and applications would be reviewed and approved by the Sports Boosters Executive Board and the High School Athletic Director. Revenue generated from participants would be used to benefit district facilities and sports programs. Sports Boosters are requesting a nominal fee to cover their costs for administering the program.

FACILITIES USE TASK FORCE (related to Policy 707)

Purpose: To establish a Fee Schedule for use of district fields and facilities that is equitable for all users, and provides a source of revenue to offset district expenses.

Objectives:

- *Review Fee Structures – options to pay by season? Any discount for multiple use?

Current Task: Committee was divided up into athletic use and non-athletic use (use of mostly the indoor facilities). Each group will evaluate the district policies that were distributed at the 5/12/10 meeting. The task is glean through the policies (or review other PA policies) to review group classification and fee structures. Groups will report back at the next meeting.
