| <p>1. Guidelines</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">105.3. TITLE I POLICY</p> <p>A. Parents of Chapter I students will be notified by letter that their child is participating in the Chapter I program in the classroom. That letter will explain the purpose of the Chapter I program and the criteria for student participation. It will identify the Chapter I staff members who are working with their student. It will invite parents to participate in an informational meeting, usually open house, where the daily instructional program will be explained to them.</p> <p>B. Following the letter of notification, parents of Chapter I students will receive a copy of the instructional goals that each student is working toward. The reading specialist will work with the students to diagnose individual and group needs. The reading specialist, the classroom teacher, the Chapter I teacher and/or aide will establish goals, identify instructional strategies and various materials needed to achieve these goals. As the student achieves one set of goals, new goals will be set.</p> <p>C. Parents will be notified of student progress in the fall and spring through personal conferences with the Chapter I teacher. They will receive written progress reports with the report card in January and June.</p> |
