117. HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION	
1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 11.25 SC 1329	The Board shall provide, pursuant to rules of the State Board of Education, individual instruction to students confined to home or hospital for physical disability, illness or injury; or when such confinement is recommended for psychological or psychiatric reasons.
2. Eligibility	<p>Application for individual instruction shall: (1) be in writing; (2) submitted to the building principal; (3) certify the nature of the illness or disability by a licensed health practitioner; (4) state the probable duration of the confinement, and (5) must be approved by the Superintendent.</p> <p>The Board designates that the Superintendent may grant such recommended requests for individual instruction.</p>
3. Program	The program of individual instruction given each student shall be in accordance with the standards established by the Secretary of Education.
4. Exception	The Board reserves the right to withhold individual instruction when the instructor's presence in the place of a student's confinement presents a hazard to the health of the teacher or if a parent or other adult in authority is not at home with the student during the hours of instruction.
