814. COPYRIGHT MATERIAL	
1. Purpose P.L.94-553 Sec. 107	The Board recognizes that the United States Code makes it illegal for anyone to duplicate copyrighted materials without permission. The Board further realizes that severe penalties are provided for unauthorized copying of audio, visual, or printed materials unless the copying falls within the bounds of the "fair use" doctrine.
2. Authority	It is the policy of the Avon Grove School District to adhere to provisions of the United States Copyright Law, P.L. 94-553 and any addendum or changes thereto. This policy pertains to: works protected by copyright (implicitly or explicitly), reproduction and use of copyrighted material in print, reproduction and use of copyrighted music, reproduction and use of copyrighted audiovisual material, and computer technologies (i.e. software, databases, optical storage media, telefacsimile, networking, site licensing, scanned images and text and multimedia productions.)
3. Responsibility 814-AP Federal Regulations P.L. 94-553	It is the responsibility of the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, or his/her designee, to inform School District employees of this policy and to act as a resource when copyright questions arise.
