All lunch **charges must be paid by June 12**. Money remaining in students' accounts will carry over to next year, even if he/she moves to AGI for the next year and their account PIN remains the same as they go from one school to the next. Please make checks payable to AG Food Service. **Breakfast and lunch will not be served on the last day of school.**



As the end of the year draws near and parents are busy with many activities, loose ends, etc., we understand that it is easy to forget to write **notes** for pick up, bus passes, and permission to stay for an after school activity. It is the responsibility of the parents' to write the notes, **not** the office staff to make phone calls to verify

what your child is to do. School procedure is that the parent of the child that is requesting the bus pass, as well as the parent that will be responsible for the student, must write a note and send it in with your child or drop it off at the school office. Phone calls, emails and faxes are not accepted (page 5, Student Handbook).

Please be aware that if your child does not have a note he/she must follow their regular dismissal routine. Also, keep in mind that we work notes on a **daily** basis, so please do not send a "blanket" note for more than 1 day. This is for the students' safety. The office staff appreciates your help with this matter.
