## Heads Up! Second Graders Study Biographies

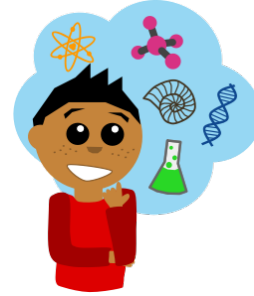
