## Dear Family:

We are in Unit 10 of Fundations ${ }^{\circledR}$ already! Your child is now going to be working with closed syllables that have five sounds. These are words that usually have a blend (two consonants each with their own sound) at the beginning of the word and a blend at the end of the word. The word " $\underline{\mathbf{s}} \mathbf{l} \mathbf{u} \underline{\mathbf{m}} \mathbf{p}$ " is an example. The $\mathbf{s l}$ is a blend and the $\mathbf{m p}$ is a blend.

I will be adding the suffixes s, ed, and ing to these five sound words as well. Remember that your child should spell the baseword first, then add the suffix ending.

Five sounds can be quite difficult to sound out, to read and to spell. I anticipate spending at least three weeks on this Unit.

I will also teach these vowel teams using the Vowel Teams poster: $\mathbf{o a}, \mathbf{o e}, \mathbf{o w}, \mathbf{o u}, \mathbf{o o}, \mathbf{u e}, \mathbf{e w}, \mathbf{a u}$, and $\mathbf{a w}$. Vowel teams are introduced for reference when students are reading throughout the day. These sounds will be learned in more depth for both reading and spelling in Level 2. In the meantime, we will practice the sounds during our Drills Sounds/Warm Up activity in class.
