



**Documentation of Employee
Status for Act 29 of 1994**

Act 29 requires school entities to categorize employees into one of two classes:

- 1- “Existing” employees – employees employed by a school district entity within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania *before* July 1, 1994.

OR

- 2- “New” employees – employees with effective dates of employment after June 30, 1994, that had NOT been employed by another school entity within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania *before* July 1, 1994.

Definitions:

- 1- School Entities – public school districts of any class, intermediate units, and area vocational technical schools
- 2- Employed – earned compensation

Note: A substitute teacher who worked at least one (1) day within the Commonwealth *before* July 1, 1994, would be considered employed *prior* to July 1, 1994 for Act 29 purposes.
