



# ESSER II and ESSER III Funds Overview:

On December 27, 2020, Congress enacted the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) and allocated funding known as ESSER II. On March 11, 2021, Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act - Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP-ESSER) and allocated funding known as ESSER III. All ESSER Funds are allocated at the state level and are intended to support COVID-19 response efforts. States must distribute at least 90% of funds to local education agencies based on their proportional share of Elementary and Secondary Education Act Title I-A funds. All ESSER II and ESSER III funding allocated to AGSD will be spent during the 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 school years.

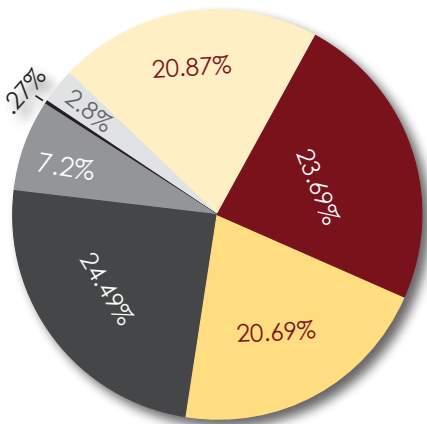

## A Breakdown of Spending:



**High Quality Academics** – Hire additional reading and math specialists and purchase classroom library resources.



**Supportive Learning Environments** – Hire a behavioral support counselor, school counselor, school psychologist, case workers and nurses.



**Healthy System Conditions** – Retain assistant principal on special assignment, hire tutoring center staff, teachers on assignment for remote learning, paraprofessionals, purchase student devices, hotspots, Zoom licenses, hire technology liaisons and interns, and retain supplemental network specialist contract.



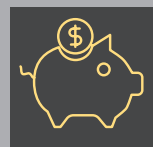
**Maintaining Safe and Clean Facilities** – Purchase cleaning/sanitizing supplies, personal protective equipment and ventilation improvements.



**Other** – Purchase COVID-19 testing kits and coordinate vaccine distribution and sites.



**Supporting Student Nutrition** – Purchase food service operational supplies and retain personnel.



**Flexible Response Reservation** – Reserved for the 2022-23 school year. Funds will be allocated to the most effective strategies based on achievement data from the 2021-22 school year.
