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Avon Grove School District held the second meeting of the Facilities Input Group (FIG) on Tuesday, June 14, 2016.

The purpose of the FIG is to develop a non-binding recommendation for a path forward for the district's facilities. After consideration of various viewpoints of FIG members, the group will deliver a plan that is aligned with the District's mission and vision to the School Board in September 2017.

The June 14th meeting was very productive. It began with FIG members reviewing a summary of the committee's May 3rd meeting. The committee members then participated in activities facilitated by Dr. Kalia Reynolds designed to develop the working norms of the committee. These norms were recorded, and the committee members concluded their meeting by refining their schedule of meeting dates and topics.

The group will meet monthly during the upcoming school year, with the exception of December 2016. The next meeting of the FIG will be held on Tuesday, August 9 at 6:30 p.m. at Penn London Elementary School. At this meeting, the committee will be given an overview of the K-2 Educational Model, the school's projected enrollment and building capacity, the state of the facility and a guided tour.
